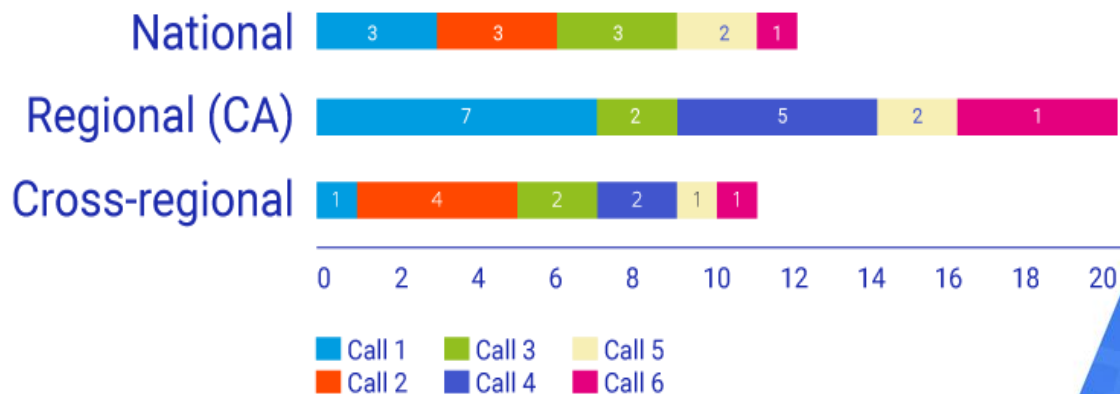

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CBHE Projects by consortium (I-VI calls)

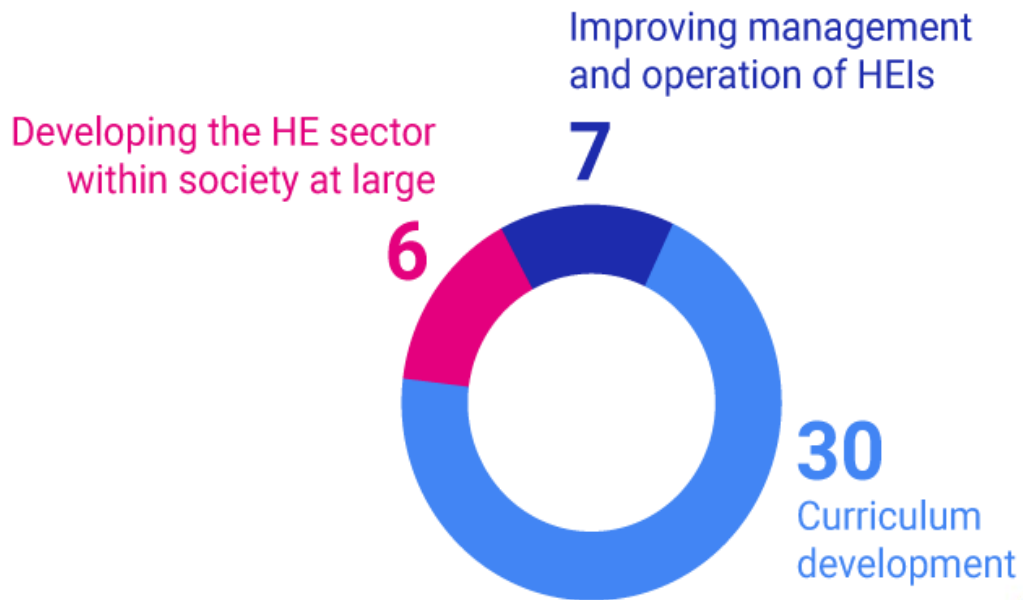

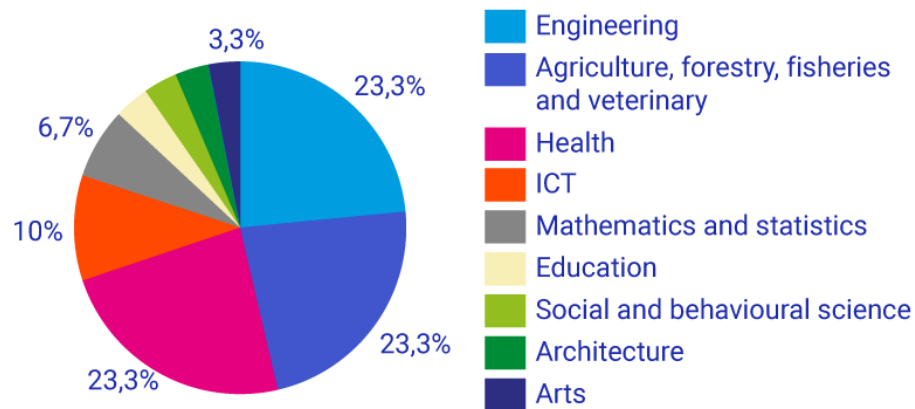
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Types of activities



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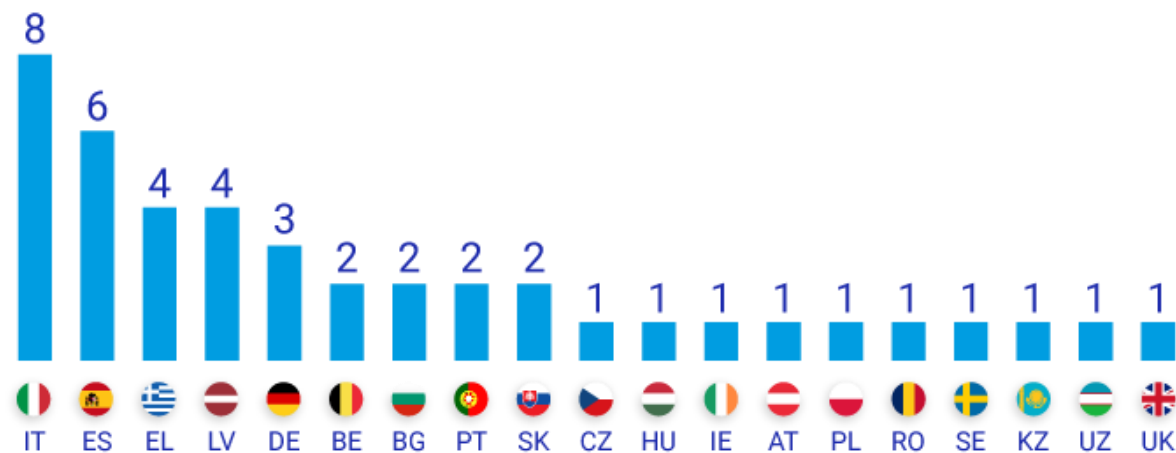
Curriculum development projects: themes



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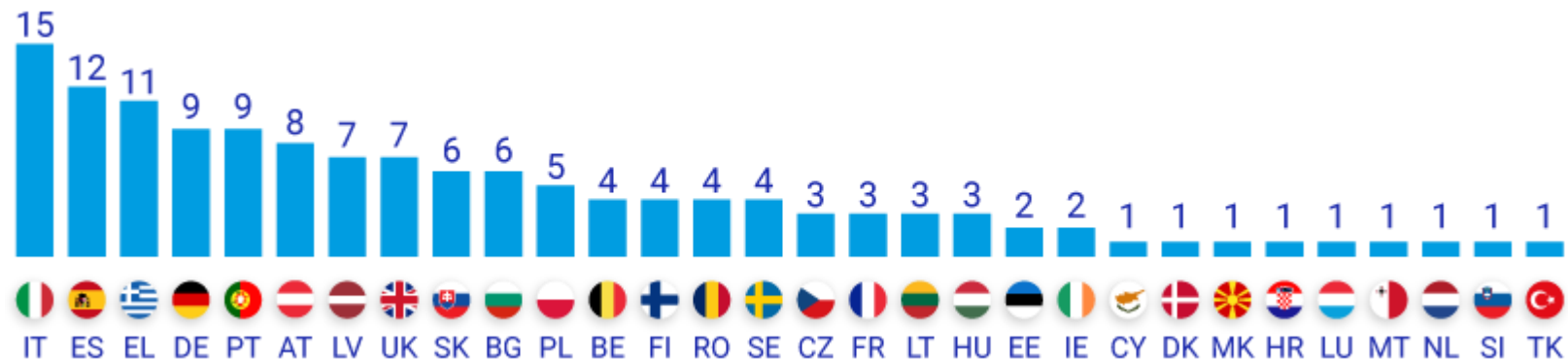
Grantholders in CBHE projects in Uzbekistan

(2015–2020)



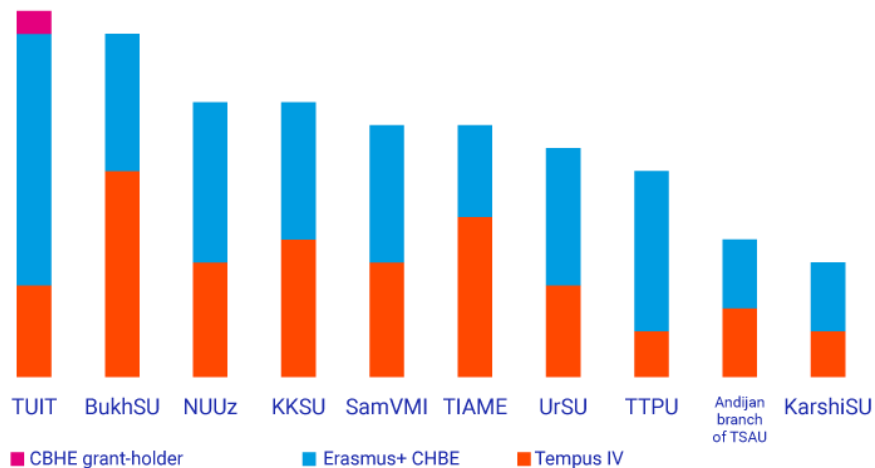
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European HEIs (27 EU Member States, North Macedonia, TK, UK) involved in CBHE projects in Uzbekistan (2015–2020)



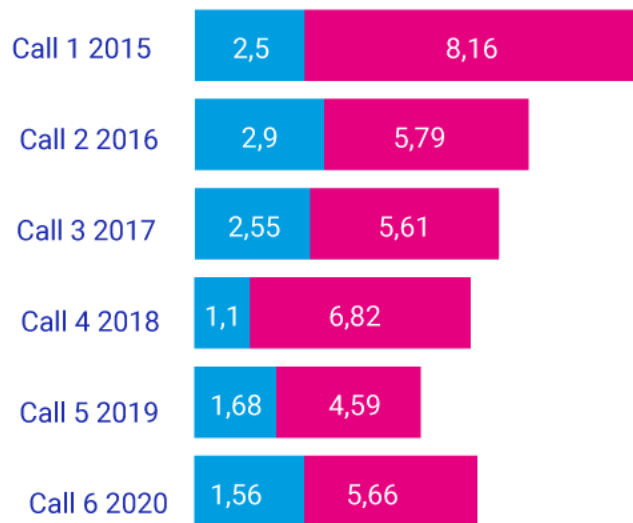
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Top 10 HEIs of Uzbekistan in Tempus IV and Erasmus+ CBHE (I-VI) projects



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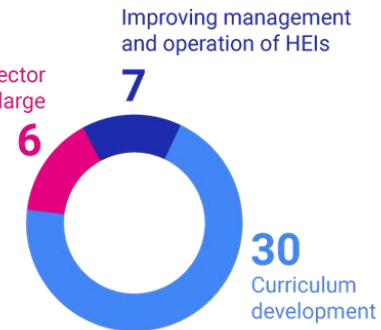

- To conduct regular dissemination activities and information events **promoting the project results** with the involvement of the mass media;
- Create a network (**association**) of Erasmus+ project coordinators and managers
- Actively promote project outcomes in **professional communities**























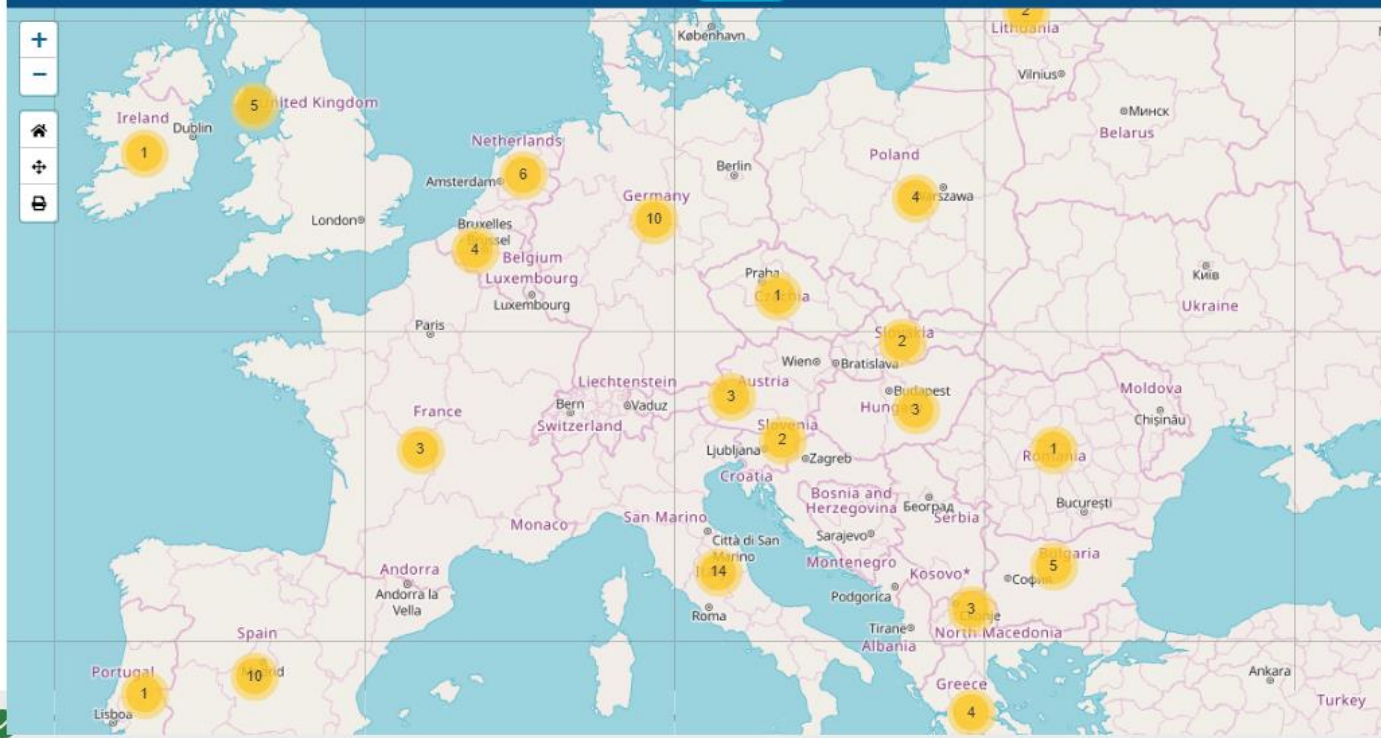
