- Promote inter-project cooperation and enhance synergy between projects (Round Table meeting) and exchange of best practices
- Assistance to institutions involved in project implementation in relation to equipment purchase and customs clearance (www.ncu.uz)
- and contacts with local authorities and the **EU Delegation**



- Advice and consultations on contract/project management
- Visa support both to EU (National Coordinating Unit) and local project participants (EU Delegation)
- ➤ Inviting the European partners to contribute to the activities of HSMC and its profile branches (biim.uz)



What difficulties/challenges can be faced during implementation?

- Administrating of project budget for local universities
- Purchase of equipment: specific procedure and role of the NCU
- Language and communication skills of local staff, abrupt changing of university administration
- Selection of project team members

Tips for partners (2)


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
- Lack of coordination between local (regional) partner institutions
