

- Nearly EUR 80 billion
- Multiannual Work Programmes
- Collaborative projects; Researcher mobility; Singlebeneficiary grants; Coordination and support actions; ...



#### What is the EU's Horizon 2020 programme?

- Almost €80 billion (current prices) research and innovation funding programme (2014-2020)
- A core part of Europe 2020, Innovation Union & European Research Area
  - Investing in future jobs and growth
  - Addressing concerns about livelihoods, safety and environment
  - Strengthening the EU's global position in research, innovation and technology
- Coupling research to innovation from research to retail, all forms of innovation
- Focus on societal challenges facing EU society, e.g. health, clean energy, transport, climate change, food security and others
- Open for participation to all companies, universities, institutes in all EU countries and everywhere in the world!



#### **H2020: Funding processes**

- Overall research priorities defined in the "EU Research & Innovation Framework Programmes" – currently Horizon 2020 (2014-2020). Published work programmes with list of topics.
- Annual calls for proposals on topics defined jointly by the European Commission and EU Member States (in the so-called Programme Committees) upon input from the scientific advisory board and the scientific communities regularly consulted.
- Evaluation of applications by panels of independent experts (3 evaluation criteria: Science & Technology; Expected Impact, Implementation & Management).
- From call for proposal submission deadline to grant signature: max. 8 months.
- Financial commitments/disbursements: Pre-financing followed by annual disbursements (on costs incurred).

#### Horizon 2020 is open to participation from across the world:

- Science is global and collaborative
- Global challenges require global cooperation
- Value chains become international
- Science (in and for) diplomacy

#### Automatic EU funding for their participation in R&I actions for:

- ✓ EU Member States (including overseas departments and overseas territories)
- Associated Countries, such as Israel, Moldova, Norway, Serbia, Turkey, Switzerland, ...
- exhaustive list of countries in annex to work programme, including Uzbekistan (!)

**Topic identifier:** LC-SC3-RES-34-2020

Type of action: IA Innovation action

Planned opening date: 05 May 2020

Deadline for proposal submission: 01 September 2020

Planned EU contribution: up to € 10 million



# Horizon 2020 call of particular interest to Central Asia - Energy

**Scope:** Projects will demonstrate innovative hydropower equipment exploiting unexplored small-scale hydropower potential in Central Asia up to 10 MW installed capacity by means of sustainable and cost-effective small-scale hydropower solutions. The demonstration activities shall take place in Central Asia (Kazakhstan, the Kyrgyz Republic, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan or Uzbekistan), with participation of local partners\*.

Proposals are expected to bring the technology from TRL 6-7 to 7-8.

The Commission considers that proposals requesting a contribution from the EU of between EUR 7 to 10 million would allow this challenge to be addressed appropriately.

Consortium requirements: in addition to the minimum number of participants, proposals must include at least two legal entities established in one of the following Central Asian countries: Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Uzbekistan.

\*Roles of local partners can include for example innovation activities, involvement of communities, dissemination, sustainability assessment etc.
